

Leadership changes at the City Menzshed

Recently two of the City Menzshed's longest serving Trustees, the Chairman, Don Matheson and Secretary John Shrapnell both resigned.



Don was appointed Chairman at our first meeting on 24 February 2011.

John wrote the Constitution of the City Menzshed and was its Founding Trustee. He formally established the charity with the Charities Commission and with Inland Revenue on the eighth of February 2011. The City Menzshed is also registered with the Government's Companies office.
